- 1. Open to all USBC certified bowlers in West Michigan who have ever bowled a certified 700 series (800 for optional).
- 2. There will be 3 Divisions 1. Women's 700 Division 2. Open 700 Division. 3. Senior's 700 Division (age 60 & over) you must designate which division you will bowl. Optional 800 Open is for all that are eligible (Men, Women or Seniors). Bowl only once. Bowl 4 games across 8 lanes (scores bowled will count for both 700 & 800 if entering both).
- 3. Bowl one division only \$35 and Optional 800 \$20 if qualified.
- 4. 90% handicap from 230 scratch for awards.
- 5. Entering average to be highest USBC final average, 21 games minimum for 2022-23 season. Summer averages will be used. Bowlers without a 2022-2023 yearbook average may use current average minimum 21 games, at time of bowling. Please bring this league sheet with you. All others will bowl scratch. (Sports & Challenge avg. to be converted)
- 6. USBC Rules 319c, 319d, and 319e shall apply to all entrants.
- 7. USBC Rules in effect. A dress code will be enforced: Slacks/pants preferred. If wearing shorts or skirts (women only), they must be knee length or longer.
- 8. ALL BOWLING EQUIPMENT MUST BE APPROVED BY USBC. NO BOWLING BALL CAN BE USED PRIOR TO RELEASE DATE TO THE PUBLIC. BOWLERS WHO VIOLATE THIS RULE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

**REMINDER:** The rule for elimination of the balance hole took effect Aug.1, 2020. All holes in a bowling ball must be used on every delivery.

- 9. Any bowler submitting a lower average than can be proven will forfeit rights to entry fees and prize monies. If submitting a higher average than required, score will be determined on same.
- 10. Prize monies returned 100%. Prize ratio to be based on 1 in 5 entrants for 700 and 1 in 10 entrants for 800 Open, Women & Senior's.
- 11. There will be an actual and handicap prize list. Bowlers can cash only once in 700 & once in 800 tournament. The prize will be the highest if placed in both actual and handicap divisions. If the cash amount is the same in both divisions, the actual score will govern.
- 12. Squads limited to 5 entrants per lane.
- 13. Entries close on the last day of tournament, if spots available.
