*******RULES & REGULATIONS*******

1. The tournament is open to all certified Greater Grand Rapids USBC Youth with a league average in the Greater Grand Rapids USBC Association jurisdiction.
2. USBC rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
3. **AVERAGES:**
 - a) Bowlers will use their highest 2021-2022 GGRUSBC yearbook average.
 - b) Bowlers having a March 4, 2023 average, minimum of 21 games, which is 10 or more pins over 2021-2022 yearbook, will use this average.
4. **IF NO YEARBOOK AVERAGE:**
 - c) Bowlers will use their highest league average, minimum of 12 games, as of March 4, 2023.
 - d) All others will bowl scratch.
 - e) Any falsification of averages may result in disqualification of bowlers.
5. The handicap to be used will be 90% of 210 scratch.
6. Bowlers will bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Substitutes will be permitted in the same lineup position as the absent bowler. Once a substitute has been put into play, the regular bowler cannot enter the lineup, unless an emergency arises. At that time Tournament Management will rule. If the name of the substitute is not on the league average sheet, he/she must present proof of average.
7. Changes should be reported to the Tournament Director as soon as possible, but not later than one half hour prior to squad time.
8. Bowlers should report to tournament office one hour before squad time.
9. Tardy bowlers must begin in the frame being bowled. MAKE UP FRAMES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN TOURNAMENT BOWLING. No absentee or vacancy scores shall be permitted.
10. No smoking, use of tobacco products, drinking of alcoholic beverages or unsportsmanlike conduct by participants will be permitted. Bowlers will not be permitted to use amusement games and/or electronic devices during his/her squad time.
11. Awards will be given using a 1 in 10 ratio, or major portion thereof, according to the number of entries in each class. First place awards will be given in all classes.
12. A fee of \$10.00 per person for each event: Lineage \$7.00, Expenses \$1.00, Awards \$2.00. Team (\$40.00 per Team), \$10.00 per person for Doubles (\$20.00 per Pair), \$10.00 per person for Singles. Optional All Events is \$3.00 per person. ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. There will be a \$20.00 fee for all checks returned NSF.
13. **Bowlers may compete FOUR TIMES in Team event – TWICE on a mixed team and TWICE on an all girls or all boys team. (All Teams must change at least 2 players on each team.) Bowlers may compete TWICE in Doubles – ONCE on a Boy/Girl team and ONCE on either a Boy/Boy or a Girl/Girl team. Bowlers may compete TWICE in Singles. Highest Singles score will determine placement in standings. If entering Doubles, bowler must enter Singles, and vice versa. First Team event, First Doubles and First Singles will count for All Events.**
14. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director within 24 hours. All mathematical errors will be corrected.
15. **PROPER BOWLING ATTIRE IS REQUIRED.** Prohibited attire includes, but is not limited to: head coverings, tank tops, pajama bottoms or clothing with offensive language/images. Slacks/pants preferred. If wearing shorts they must be knee length or longer.
16. As required by the bowling center – neither food nor drink may not be brought into the bowling center. Please respect the Proprietor's rules.
17. Bowlers may be required to show proof of membership, such as: membership card, copy of membership card or membership receipt at check in.
18. Bowlers are asked to provide their own bowling equipment (balls and shoes) and not share equipment with other tournament bowlers.
