*****NEW RULE*** If you have not had a 600 series in the last 5 years, you have the option of bowling in the 500 Club Division.**

1. All entrants must be female members in good standing of the USBC on all levels through the Greater Grand Rapids USBC and the respective National 600 Club or Grand Rapids 500 Club.
2. Entrants will use their highest Greater Grand Rapids USBC yearbook average for the 2021-2022 season. Summer averages will be used. A bowler with no 2021-2022 yearbook average will use her highest current GGRUSBC average, minimum 21 games, at the time of her participation the tournament. She must bring an average sheet with her. All others will bowl scratch.
3. Entrants need to report an increase in average of 10 or more pins as of their participation in the tournament.
4. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of her own average. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
5. Handicap will be based on 90% of 230 scratch.
6. Tardy bowlers will start in the frame then being bowled and a zero will be given for each frame missed.
7. Entrants may bowl only one time. Four games will be bowled across 8 lanes. Entrants should check in one hour prior to their squad and show their USBC Membership card (or receipt) and National 600 Club or Greater Grand Rapids 500 Club card. Lanes will be assigned. Entrants wanting to bowl together should submit entries together.
8. Entry Fee: \$30.00 – Prize fund: \$15.00 – Bowling Fee: \$12.00 – Expenses: \$3.00. Optional Actual Prize Fund: additional \$5.00. Checks should be made payable to the Greater Grand Rapids USBC (GGRUSBC). Returned checks will be assessed a \$20.00 fee.
9. Walk-in entries will be accepted based on lane availability and at a cost of \$35.00 per person. *Note: The \$5.00 additional fee will be added to the prize fund.* Squads will be limited to 4 bowlers per lane.

10. No substitutions or replacements will be allowed.
11. Prize money will be returned 100%. Prize ratio will be at least 1 in 5 entries. *Note: Each Club will have their own prize list – 500 Club separate from 600 Club.* Trophies will be awarded to winners of both the Handicap and Actual divisions.
12. Rule 319d will be waived; Rule 319e is in effect.
13. Pacers will not be allowed.
14. The delivery used in tournament competition must be the same as that used in establishing the entering average.
15. An entry can neither be sold nor transferred. A reserved entry may be refunded if cancelled prior to the reserved entry closing date of the tournament. The Tournament Committee will make final decision on refunds.
16. The Tournament Committee will decide any questions, disputes or situations not covered in these tournament rules.
17. Optional Doubles: \$5.00 each person (for Prize Fund only). Scores for participants to be combined with handicap for this additional prize list. Ratio to be at least 1 in 6 entries. Doubles will consist of one bowler from 500 Club and one bowler from 600 Club. Both bowlers must also be entered in Tournament, but they do not have to bowling the same squad.
