ADULT / YOUTH BAKER DOUBLES TOURNAMENT

***** RULES *****

- 1. <u>ELIGIBILITY:</u> This event is open to all 2021-2022 certified USBC Youth members. All Adult bowlers must be a USBC certified member in good standing. If an Adult is not presently a 2021-2022 USBC member, a Basic membership can be purchased at the time of check-in (\$11.00). Current USBC membership cards must be shown at check-in.
- ENTRY FEE & DEADLINE DATE: A \$45.00 entry fee must be paid at the time of entry. Entries postmarked after June 30, 2022 will be \$50.00. Walk-in entries will be \$50.00 cash only. (ATM available on site) Re-entries will be \$50.00 and allowed on a first-come, first-served basis, based on lane availability.
- 3. <u>**TEAMS & DIVISIONS:**</u> Each doubles team consists of a USBC certified Youth bowler (not required to be a 2022 Junior Gold or Youth Open participant) and a USBC certified Adult bowler. There is no age requirement for the Adult bowler. There will be separate Boys and Girls divisions in U12, U15 and U18. The age of the Youth bowler as of August 1, 2021 will determine the division.
- ON-SITE REGISTRATION: On-site registration at Northfield Lanes before and after Thursday, July 14, 2022 will cost <u>\$50.00 (CASH ONLY)</u>. Acceptance will be on a first-come, first-served basis and based on squad time and lane availability.

Entries will also be accepted at the Adult/Youth Tournament booth during Junior Gold registration on Saturday, July 16, 2022 at DeVos Place.

- 5. **FORMAT:** Each doubles team will bowl four (4) Baker-style games. Baker-style games are where one bowler throws the first frame and their partner throws the next frame. The Youth bowler will be on the odd (left) lane and the Adult bowler on the even (right) lane. Teams will bowl all 4 games on the same pair of lanes. The lane condition will be a modified house pattern with no redressing of lanes between squads. This is a USBC certified scratch tournament.
- 6. <u>SCHOLARSHIPS</u>: The scholarship portion of the entry fee will be returned 100% with scholarships held in the USBC SMART Program in Arlington, Texas. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:6 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC Youth bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament; however, they may only receive 1 (one) scholarship with the same partner.
